Here are some details about the Spring 2023 UNM-PNM contest, including a zoom link for the guest speaker on February 12. I apologize for this email going out so late to you.

Schedule:

10:00 - 11:00am Guest Speaker (over zoom), Laura Kubatko (The Ohio State University) 11:00am - 1:00pm break

1:00pm - 4:45pm Test (after brief announcements)

We intended to invite anyone with a score of 20% or higher on the first round to participate in the second round. However, there were problems with the online system used, Flexiquiz, and several students who started the first round of the test did not end up with a submitted quiz. Data for these students were lost, and it is not possible to reconstruct a score. Consequently, we are opening round 2 to anyone who would like to participate, even if the score was lower than 20%. Prizes awarded later in the semester are only based on round 2 performance, not on round 1.

The contest will be in person in the Science and Math Learning Center (SMLC), room 102, on UNM main campus, on Sunday, Feb 12th. The building is listed as building number 14 on the campus map located here:
